- Designed to work in collaboration with your institutions' advocacy efforts with federal elected officials in your area
- This initiative will work in tandem with HACU's advocacy efforts in DC while expanding our combined efforts in our local communities





Local Engagement Initiative

- Goals of the LEI is two-fold:
 - Provide support and encouragement of legislative action on the concerns and issues (i.e. HEA Reauthorization) to HSIs
 - 2) Provide guidance and resources for member institutions on structure, outreach methods, and initiating and sustaining engagement with federal government officials

 - Sign up to receive the latest news/updates on federal policies and legislative proposals impacting HSIs and Hispanic students.










