



HACU 2024-2025 Hispanic-Serving Institutions and Emerging HSIs: State Breakdown and State by State Comparison of Total Hispanic Undergraduate Enrollment

The State-by-State Comparison offers a national overview of the distribution of HSIs and Emerging HSIs with the total number of each institution type by state. This document additionally includes the total number of undergraduate students and the total number of Hispanic undergraduate students enrolled in each state. The proportion of Hispanic students relative to the total is listed as well. These numbers represent total enrollment within the state and include both HSIs and non-HSIs.

HSI: 2 year & 4 year, public and private, nonprofit institution with 25.0% minimum Hispanic Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) enrollment

Emerging HSI: 2 year & 4 year, public and private, nonprofit institution with 15.0% - 24.99% Hispanic Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) enrollment

HC: Headcount, total number of students enrolled including full-time and part-time students. Unlike with full-time equivalent (FTE), part-time students are counted individually.

UG: Undergraduate students

Percent Hispanic HC: This column indicates the total headcount of Hispanic students in the state relative to the total number of students enrolled.
